Waiting on God

I choose Your plans for me and my family!


I thank You that as I live in Your love that I can show love to others and give patience, forgiveness and acceptance to those around me.

God's words are timeless. Some would argue that miracles ended with the book of Acts, but God's promises don't have an expiration date. Jesus said, "Heaven and earth will pass away, but my words will by no means pass away" (Mark 13:31, NKJV). Great Exploits

"I will confirm my covenant with you and your descendants after you, from generation to generation. This is the everlasting covenant: I will always be your God and the God of your descendants after you."

GENESIS 17:7 (NLT)

God is all about generations. In fact, one of the reasons He chose to make the old covenant with Abraham was because of how Abraham viewed family. God knew this man would pass his faith down to the next generation.

We must ensure that we do not let this world remove the incredible honour and importance of raising our children. It's not just a side hustle or a part-time job. We have a responsibility to make sure each generation is being prepared to serve God.

Others might not value the work you do to raise those kids. Your own children may not recognize the sacrifices you make. But every time you teach them God's Word, you plant a seed in their hearts. Sometimes seeds take a while to come up. But as time goes on and your children go through the seasons of life, they will come to realize the importance of the faith you demonstrated.

The more you know God and allow Him to work through you, your children will also see that and come to experience Him in their lives as well.

Raising the Next Generation

"But watch out! Be careful never to forget what you yourself have seen.

Do not let these memories escape from your mind as long as you live!

And be sure to pass them on to your children and grandchildren."

DEUTERONOMY 4:9 (NLT)

We need to fill our family's imagination with God's Word! Psalm 78:4 (NLT) says, "We will not hide these truths from our children; we will tell the next generation about the glorious deeds of the Lord, about His power and His mighty wonders."

As parents and grandparents, we need to fill our family's imagination with God's Word. God's principles are so powerful that when you teach them to your kids—even from birth—it's like planting seeds in the ground. In the life of Moses, we saw how his mother taught him God's Word at a young age. Later, when he felt the pull of Egyptian riches, fame and power, he still rejected those temptations and chose to follow God.

If we don't teach our children the Word, and only teach them how to be moral we are missing the mark on God's best. Morality is important, please be moral, but it doesn't teach a child his or her identity. When we plant God's Word in our children's hearts, it shows them who they are in Christ, how much God loves them and the amazing future He has for them.
