# Two Steps to Register for Springs Summer Camp 2025

We are excited to announce that this year, our camp registration will be done in a two-step process starting with registering via email.

This means everyone can register from the comfort of their home!

#### Two Steps for Your Summer Camp Accommodation Booking:

#### Step 1: Email Registration:

You must let us know via email that you are interested in booking a Summer Camp accommodation. When the registration time opens, simply send your email and we will process them in the order they are received (we will check our spam folder as well). This will give us both your place in line for your accommodation booking.

#### Accommodation Booking Number:

After receiving your email, we will respond to you with your accommodation booking number, this gives both of us your place in line for booking your preferred accommodation, which will be done in-person.

#### Step 2: In-Person Accommodation Booking Evening:

Join us on the Winnipeg Café Patio for the IN-PERSON Accommodation Booking Evening. This is where you will book your accommodation, the number you received in the email from us is the number you are in line. We will have a list available with each family name and number in case you need to confirm your number. We will also have a list of the available accommodations, which will continuously be updated as they are booked. This way, you can re-consider your options while waiting for your turn.

#### Timing Matters:

Please do not send your registration email before 7:00am on Tuesday, May 20. Emails received prior to 7:00am will not be processed.

#### One Email Registration per Family:

Each family is allowed to submit only one registration email.

#### Can't Make It?:

If you cannot attend the in-person Accommodation Booking Evening on May 20, you may have someone do this for you. Just send us an email letting us know who will be representing you that evening.

#### On Time:

If your number is called and you are not there, we will need to move on to the next family. We do not want to keep other families waiting.

# Springs Summer Camp Monday, July 21 – Sunday, July 27, 2025

Our desire is that Summer Camp would be a place where we can kick back and get to know each other. We have structured the days at Summer Camp to be relaxing, but yet fun and exciting. There is something to do for ALL ages!!

Our Annual Springs Summer Camp is held at Manhattan Beach Retreat Centre along the shores of Pelican Lake. The camp is 5 miles east of Ninette, MB and 1 mile south off Highway #23.

#### **Accommodations:**

There is a wide range of accommodations at Summer Camp to suit both small and large families or those needing just a single accommodation. There are different sized cabins, motel rooms, a campground with full service sites, water and electric only sites and tent sites. The campground has a public washroom building with showers for those camping or in camp cabins. The accommodations range in price from \$400.00 - \$1,200.00 for the entire week depending on the size of the accommodation and the amenities in that unit.

#### Dining Hall:

The camp has a Dining Hall where breakfast, lunch and dinner can be purchased each day. After the evening services they have snacks and refreshments available for purchase. You are welcome to eat all your meals in the Dining Hall or just show up when you feel like 'taking a break from the kitchen'. The cabins also have fridges and cook tops if you are interested in preparing your own meals during the week. Some motel units have a common kitchen area where families can prepare meals and store their grocery items. The Dining Hall also has the option of a Prepaid Meal Plan.

#### Prepaid Meal Plans:

By ordering a Prepaid Meal Plan you will receive a discounted price of 20% from the regular rate in the Dining Hall. You can order any combination of meals - suppers only or just lunches, any amount of days or the entire week. See page 5 for more information on this.

Payment will be due when you book your Meal Plan. These Meal Plans can be booked on Friday, May 30 when you book your accommodation or after that by calling the church office at 204-233-7003.

Deadline to book your Prepaid Meal Plan is Wednesday, July 3.

We spend months planning and prepping for our Summer Camp; the services, the Kids and Youth programs and activities, the adult times, etc (and love every minute of it!!!). Each and every item we use at camp is loaded on a large truck and brought out from Winnipeg. We have amazing volunteers who help us do what we do for camp week – we so appreciate each one of them!! Camp is a week-long party with the family!!

## Summer Camp Daily Schedule

#### In the Morning:

Each morning from 10:00 – 11:30 we have two separate classes for:

Children ages 3 – 5 (must be this age before August 31/25)

Grade 1 – Grade 6 (grade entering in September/25)

Both these classes are with our Kids Staff and College Alumni. Here they will have activities, games, crafts, etc. around a theme in God's Word.

Youth (Grade 7 - 12; grade entering in September/25) also gather together each morning for a devotion/study time of their own with our Youth Leaders.

The adults have a chance to relax over coffee with your neighbours or take part in the activities we have happening while the kids are in their classes.

#### In the Afternoon:

After lunch there are always things to do!

- The fully life-guarded swimming pool is open from 1:00pm 5:00pm daily (no extra charge).
- There is a mini-golf course open from 1:00pm 5:00pm daily (no extra charge).
- If you have a boat or other watercraft, you are welcome to bring it along; Pelican Lake has plenty of room for fishing, skiing, tubing and other water sports.
- Lots of people gather at the beach for the afternoon just to take in the sun.
- Some gather together for a wild (and competitive) game of beach volleyball, mini-golf or other challenges/games we may have planned.
- The camp has a Pontoon Boat, you can go out on an afternoon lake tour between 2pm and 4pm (no extra charge a driver will be provided).
- The camp has a concession store with ice cream, slushies and other treats (no groceries items or ice).
- Golfers, bring your clubs! There are a couple great courses within a short drive.
- Even shopping can be done girls; Killarney (about a 20-minute drive) has a small mall!
- Ninette (about a 5-minute drive) has a well-stocked grocery store with fresh produce, meat counter, groceries, ice and snack supplies. This store also has a gas station.
- Our Youth Leaders are at Summer Camp and have a full schedule of events planned for the youth each day.

#### In the Evening:

Each evening at 7:30pm (for about an hour) the adults and youth gather in the Adult Chapel for our service. We spend time together in praise and worship and learning from His Word from some of our great pastors.

During our evening service, children ages 3 – Grade 6 will again go to Springs Kids Classes with our staff and College Alumni. We also have a nursery available during the service for ages 2 and under, this is volunteer run so we ask that parents take a turn one evening to help out.

The Youth will be getting together each evening at 9:30pm for team challenges and fun games.

There are campfires going after the service, bring your lawn chair and spend some time around the campfire relaxing and getting to know one another – don't forget your snacks and marshmallows!

# What the Camp Has to Offer

#### **SWIMMING POOL**

Regular Swimming Pool hours are 1pm-5pm daily

The camp provides fully trained lifeguards any time the pool is open.

**NOTE:** There is NO charge to swim at the pool during regular swimming pool hours or our evening swims – this is included in your registration fee.

#### MINIATURE GOLF COURSE

Mini Golf hours are 1pm-5pm daily

NOTE: There is NO charge to mini golf during regular hours – this is included in your registration fee.

#### PONTOON BOAT

Pontoon Boat regular hours of operation for lake touring are 2pm-4pm daily (weather permitting) NOTE: There is NO charge to go on a lake tour during regular hours – this is included in your registration fee.

#### **LAUNDROMAT**

Available to anyone staying in the camp, it is in the campground area – the machines are coin operated (\$2.00 for washer, \$2.00 for dryer). Laundry soap is available at the camp office for a small fee.

#### CAMP CONCESSION

Available each afternoon from 1pm-5pm and again after the evening services. It sells snack items like ice cream, candy, chips, etc. (no groceries or ice)

#### DINING HALL MEALS

Full course meals are available in the Camp Dining Room at very reasonable rates.

Prepaid Meal Plans available – this allows you to book your desired meals before going to camp to receive a 20% discount.

NOTE: The Prepaid Meal Plan 20% discount cannot be applied to the evening snacks after the services.

#### LOCATION

Manhattan Beach Retreat Centre is located 5 miles east of Ninette, MB and then 1 mile south off of Highway #23. The camp is on the shores of Pelican Lake. It is about a 2 ½ hour drive west of Winnipeg. (see map attached)

Ninette is 5 minutes away, they have a grocery store and gas station; Killarney is 20 minutes away, they have 2 grocery stores as well as other various stores.

# Prepaid Meal Plans Save 20% off your Dining Hall meals!

By ordering a Prepaid Meal Plan you will receive a discounted price of 20%. You can order any combination of meals - suppers only or just lunches, any amount of days or the entire week.

You would be able to choose what days you want to go for the lunches and/or dinners you have prepaid for. Menus are posted the day before so you can decide if that is something your family will enjoy.

Some families prefer to do their own cooking, with the Prepaid Meal Plan discount it makes it easier to do a combination of your own cooking and taking some nights off and eating in the Dining Hall.

Your name and meal plan will be registered with the Dining Hall cashier before you arrive at camp.

Example Only to give you an idea of the savings of the Pre-Paid Meal Plan: if there are 4 people in your family (2 adults and 2 teens) you could create a Prepaid Meal Plan like this:

Payment will be due when you book your meal plan. These Meal Plans can be booked on Friday, May 30 when you book your accommodation. Or after that by calling the church office at 204-233-7003. Deadline to book your Prepaid Meal Plan is Wednesday, July 3.

NOTE: If you decide that you want to eat a fifth supper in the Dining Hall that week, then you would just pay the regular rate to the cashier at the counter.

ACCOMMODATIONS WILL ONLY BE RESERVED WITH A REGISTRATION FEE AT TIME OF BOOKING \$350.00 registration fee for 3 nights or more - \$125.00 registration fee for 2 nights or less

This registration fee is in addition to the cost of your accommodation. This fee is non-refundable


#### DAILY RATES AVAILABLE FOR ACCOMMODATIONS IF NEEDED

If you can only attend Summer Camp for a few days, you can calculate a daily rate on any accommodation. Please divide the weekly rate by six nights - example weekly rate of  $$575.00 \div 6 = $96.00/$ night (incl GST)


